Six Biblical Perspectives on How We Should Think About Money

1) We don't own ANYTHING. It all belongs to God.

Psalm 24:1 (NIV) *The earth is the Lord's, and everything in it, the world, and all who live in it.*

2) Money is NOT the root of all evil.

1 Timothy 6:10 (NIV) *For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil. Some people, eager for money, have wandered from the faith and pierced themselves with many griefs.*

Matthew 16:26 (NIV) *What good will it be for someone to gain the whole world, yet forfeit their soul? Or what can anyone give in exchange for their soul?*

3) Money REVEALS who we really are and what we love and trust most.

Matthew 6:21 (NIV) *For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.*

4) Don't expect money to SATISFY.

Ecclesiastes 5:10 (NIV) *Whoever loves money never has enough; whoever loves wealth is never satisfied with their income. This too is meaningless.*

Proverbs 23:5 (NIV) *Cast but a glance at riches, and they are gone, for they will surely sprout wings and fly off to the sky like an eagle.*

5) One day I will give an ACCOUNT to God.

6) The best use of money is to use it to GET PEOPLE to HEAVEN.

Luke 19:10 (NIV) *For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost.*
